AWANA was founded in 1950 and has clubs worldwide. Its purpose is to introduce children and youth to Christ. It has a club atmosphere, provides opportunities for making friends while having fun. AWANA lessons are based on Christ's example, teaching positive values and building characters. Clubbers learn sportsmanship, how to be a team player, and how to respect each other.

Each AWANA night is divided into three sections:

Large Group Time: A great worship time with prayer and song. Clubbers, even our youngest, love to sing their favorite songs. Worship is followed by a lesson time, where God's word is applied to their lives in ways they can understand.

Game Time: Awana games are typically based on team competition. They are fast paced, fun activities, thoroughly enjoyed by the clubbers. The format of Cubbie games differs to accommodate their age.

Handbook Time: This is a small group time when clubbers memorize the Bible verses. They work with their leaders to learn God's word, understand the meaning, and apply it to their lives.
